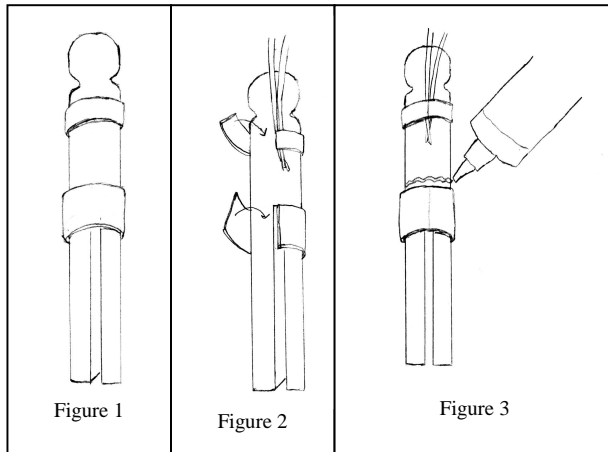


## Ice Fairy Clothespin Ornament

- 1) Paint the entire clothespin flesh color and let it dry.
- 2) Using pattern 1 from the patterns page cut the wings from the gold mesh.
- 3) Cut a piece of blue chenille stem 5 inches long. Bend it in half first, then bend it into the shape of the top of the wings as seen in pattern 1.
- 4) Use a thin line of glue along the entire length of the chenille stem and glue it to the top of the wings.



5) Cut a piece of 1/8 inch blue hanging ribbon 12 inches long. Glue the ends on the back of the clothespin just below the neck. See figure 2.

6) Cut the bikini from the blue felt. Use pattern 6 from the patterns sheet. The top part is 2 inches by one quarter of an inch. The bottom is 2 inches by one half of an inch.

7) Glue the larger piece of felt around the Fairy's waist and the thinner piece of felt around her top. Leave a space above her top and below her neck for the arms to attach. Make sure the seams are in the back where the hanging ribbon was glued. See figures 1 and 2.

8) Cut two pieces of blue felt one and a half inches by one half inch and glue them around the bottom of each leg for boots.

9) Cut a piece of cardboard 2 inches wide and 4 inches long. Cut a piece of white string 12 inches long and set it aside. Wrap the remaining string around the short width of the cardboard (2 inches width) 100 times. Cut one side of the string you just wrapped around the cardboard. See figure 4. You should now have 100 pieces of string about 4 inches long.

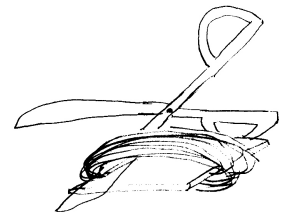
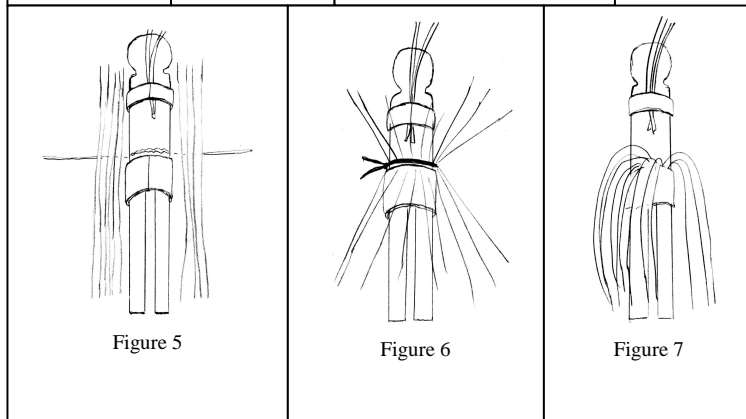

10) Place a line of glue around the Fairy's waist just above the bikini bottom (see figure 3).

11) Lay the 12 inch string out from left to right. Straighten the bunch of string you just cut from the cardboard and place it across the 12 inch string, laying them up and down so the 12 inch string is centered. See figure 5. Spread them out a little bit from left to right so they will wrap around the clothespin. Next, set the clothespin on top of the string like it is drawn in figure 5.



12) Pick up the ends of the 12 inch piece of string and tie it around the waist of the clothespin. Tie the 12 inch piece of string tight. Make sure it is sitting just above the bikini bottom where you put the glue. See figure 6.

13) Let the upper half of the string flop down to form a skirt. See figure 7. Let it dry. Trim the bottom if necessary.

14) Cut a piece of blue chenille stem 4 inches long and bend the ends over to form hands as seen in figure 8.

15) Bend the chenille stem around the back of the Fairy so the arms are facing straight out in front. See figure 8.

16) Place glue on the back of the clothespin just above the bikini top and glue the arms in place.

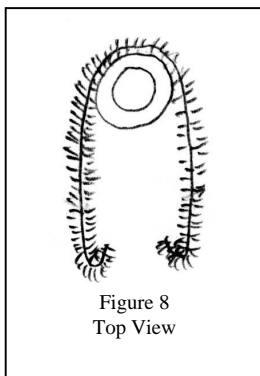

17) Roll the blonde doll hair up into a tight ball in the palm of your hand. It may be easier if you get your palm wet first. Pull the ball of hair into a pancake shape about the size of a quarter. Cover the top and back of the head with glue and hold the hair in place until it dries enough to hold then let it sit to dry all the way.

18) Cut a piece of wire 6 inches long and string the seed beads onto it about 60 beads. Twist the ends together and double it up so there are two loops of beads. Glue it to the top of the Fairy's head.

19) Glue the wings to the back of the Fairy. The blue chenille stem should be in the front. Glue the tip of the "v" just under the arms on the back of the Fairy.

20) Glue on the eyes and draw a mouth with a fine felt tip pen.
