

Wizard of Oz Dorothy

1) Paint the body of the clothespin white up to the neck. Leave the neck and head natural or paint it a flesh color. Let it dry.

2) Cut the dress out of the blue and white checkered cloth. Follow the pattern in figure 1.

3) Cut a piece of 1/8" hanging ribbon about 12 inches long and glue the ends to the back of the clothespin half way between the head and the legs. See figure 2.

4) Place a thin line of glue around the upper body of the clothespin as in figure 2.

5) Wrap the dress you cut out in step 2 around the clothespin, leaving the opening in the back where the hanging ribbon is glued. See figure 3. The dress will overlap in the back. Don't worry if it sticks out a bit. Make sure that the bottom of the dress puffs out and is not flat against the clothespin. Only the top of the dress should be flat against the clothespin.

6) Cut a piece of white chenille about 3 1/2 inches long. Bend the tips of the pipe cleaner over to make hands and put a slight bend in the center. Glue this on the back of the clothespin over the hanging ribbon. See figure 4.

7) Cut a piece of light blue 1/8" ribbon about 12 inches long. Wrap the ribbon around Dorothy's waste and tie a bow in the back like you were tying your shoe. Place a drop of glue under the bow to hold it in place.

8) Next, glue on the hair and make another bow like the one in step 7 and glue it to the top of her hair.

9) Glue on eyes and make a face using a fine felt tip pen. 10) Finally, paint on her ruby red slippers.

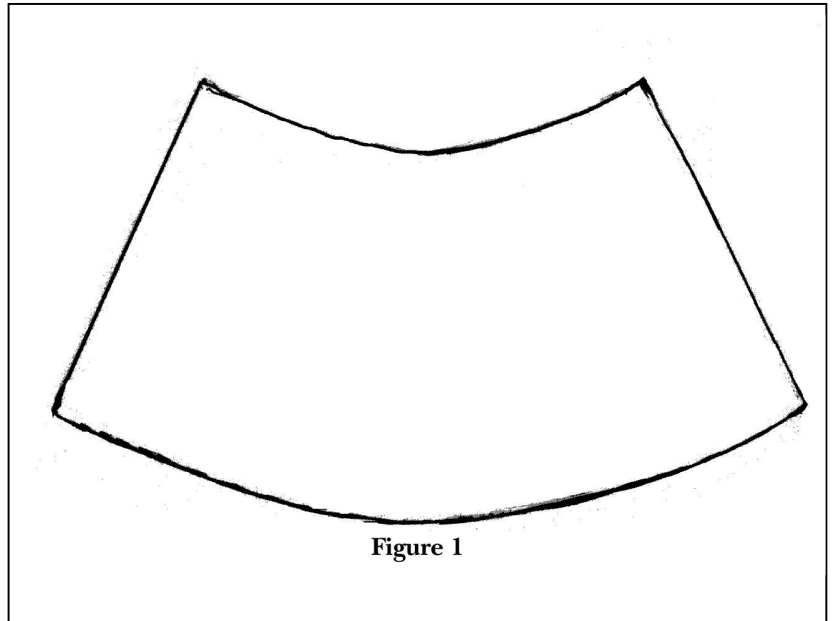

- 5"x3" blue & white material

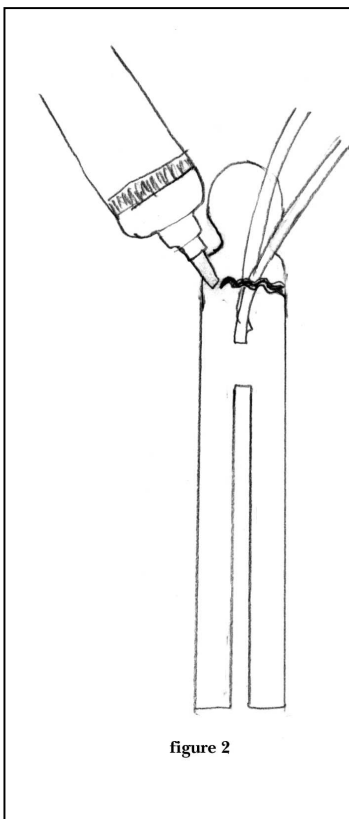

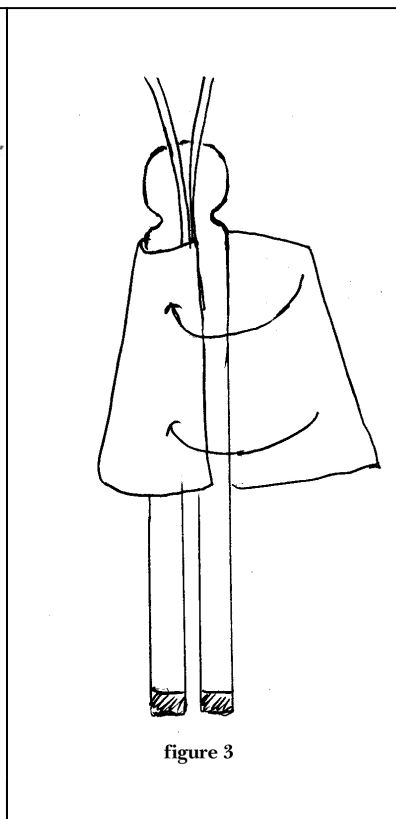

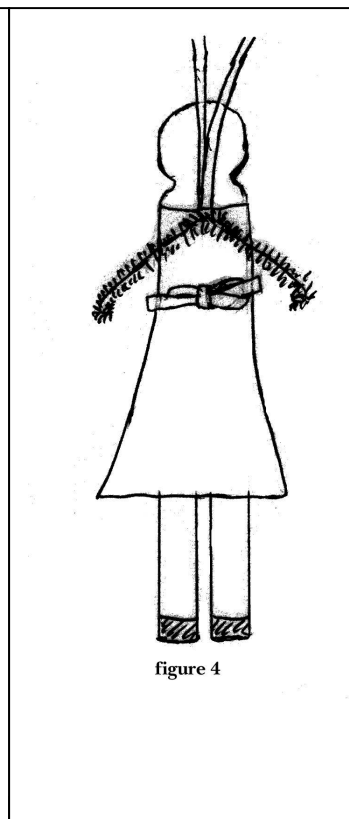

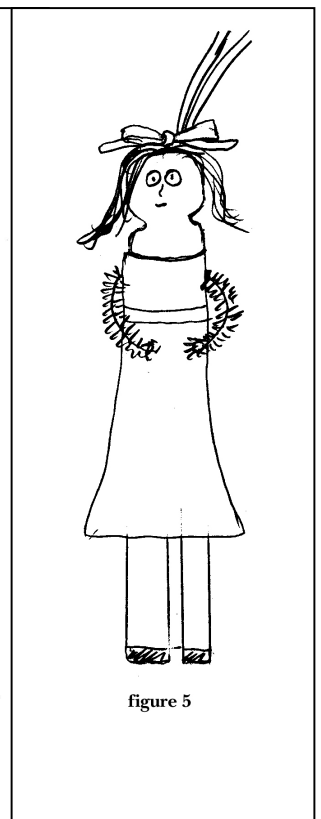
